On Friday January 24th 2020 is the Annual March for Life in Washington D.C. This year Our Lady of Lourdes Parish has chartered a bus to bring members of our parish to attend the March. The March for Life is an experience that you will never forget and is an important way for Catholics to stand up for the sanctity of all human life. IT'S OUR FAITH, LET'S LIVE IT!

The day will start with a Mass at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. We will then join hundreds of Thousands of others from across the country to give voice to the voiceless in the annual march up Constitution Avenue to the U.S. Supreme Court. Students attending the march will receive an excused absence from school and also receive service hours. All students must be accompanied by an adult who will be responsible for the student. Cost for a spot on the bus is \$25 for adults and \$10 for students, or \$50 for a family of 4 or more.
