Purpose of the Blue Envelope: There are often questions about the blue envelopes in your monthly packet. The blue envelope is very important to the life of the parish. It was originally used to help pay off the John A Acri Parish Center. These same envelopes are being used now to help maintain the buildings and grounds. Things like roof repairs, handicap accessible doors, upkeep on kitchen appliances, and anything else that is outside our normal church operating budget. The white envelope is your regular giving that helps sustain our normal operating budget. Thank you for your generosity.
